Cool New Resources:

- **Methamphetamine: A Prevention Trilogy**, was put out by the California Department of Justice. It is a collection of three short videos that address different aspects of methamphetamine use. *Meth: The Great Deceiver* is geared towards teens and addresses health and addiction issues. *Where Meth Goes... Violence and Destruction Follow* discusses the more violent problems caused by meth, such as child and domestic abuse. The last section, *Hidden Dangers: Meth Labs* details the impact meth labs have on the community and environment. - **Substance Abuse Treatment, Prevention and Policy** is a new online peer-reviewed journal. It is open access, so all articles are available to view for free. April 20, 2006 10:00 am (PST) "Kids, Drugs & Violence"

Sponsored by the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC), the webcast description follows: "Juvenile crime will always be a challenge that law enforcement, schools and our communities face. But there is an emerging face to one particular crime that is getting younger: Drug dealing. A rising number of kids are selling dope on the streets, in our neighborhoods and in our schools. And there is one thing that goes hand-in-hand with drugs - crime, violent crime.

Sgt. Harold Rochon, a veteran of the Detroit Police Department and expert trainer on gangs and author of "Terrorists in Designer Jeans," will show you just how serious and dangerous the rising rate of juvenile drug dealers is in our country and how it's affecting our schools and communities. You will learn how and why adult drug dealers recruit juveniles into their organization and how parents can recognize signs that their child may be selling drugs. He will also discuss effective strategies at identifying the problem, fighting it, and preventing it from spreading."

May 3, 2006 "Helping the Labor Movement Embrace Recovery."

"The labor movement has historically been a beacon for improved workplace conditions and has helped to make tremendous strides toward improving the lives of millions of workers. Still, most experts agree that much work is left to be done when it comes to addressing alcohol and drug addiction issues as they relate to occupational health and well-being. The show will look at occupations most at risk for substance abuse and discuss what labor organizations can do to help their ranks fully address these issues." The host will be Ivette Torres, Associate Director for Consumer Affairs, Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT), Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). Invited panelists will be Robert Lindsey, President, National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence, Inc. (NCADD); Frank Migliaccio, Executive Director, International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental, and Reinforcing Iron Workers; Jamie Becker, Behavioral Health Care Coordinator, Laborers' Health and Safety Fund of North America; Ann Price, Co-Chair, United Airlines, The Association of Flight Attendants (AFA), Employee Assistance Program (EAP)." NPRC Materials Update
