SALIS Conference Reports

It has been a few months now since we took our trip to Boston for the SALIS conference, however we still have a lot to report! This month, I would like to tell you about a great presentation on open access journals.

Sheila Lacroix, the library coordinator for the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, as well as Pearl Johnson from the University of Toronto made a very informative presentation on open access journals. Open access journals are available online and their content is free to everyone. During this presentation, several journals were discussed. I will give a brief introduction to each.

- **Substance Abuse Treatment Prevention Policy:** This journal covers all aspects of substance abuse. It is peer reviewed and includes information on research, policy, methodology and commentary. It's website is <http://www.substanceabusepolicy.com/>
- **Journal of FAS International:** This is a peer reviewed journal dedicated to the issue of fetal alcohol spectrum disorder and is the official journal of the FACE (Fetal Alcohol Canadian Expertise) Research Network. It can be found at http://www.motherisk.org/JFAS/econtent_about.jsp
- **Journal of Gambling Issues:** This journal is out of Canada and is issued 2-3 times per year. It features articles on gambling and gambling related topics from all over the world. It can be accessed at <http://www.camh.net/egambling/>.
- **Harm Reduction Journal:** This journal receives articles on "all aspects of minimizing the adverse effects of psychoactive drugs the public policies meant to control them, and the search for effective methods of reducing the adverse medical, public health, and social consequences associated with both drugs and drug policies."
