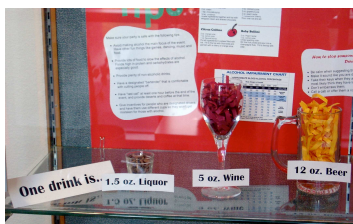
Planning Ahead

NPRC Events:

This December, the NPRC put up a "Safe and Healthy Holiday Season" display in the Learning and Resource Center on the UNR campus. Cool New Resources:

- **Monitoring the Future** is a long standing study of the behaviors, attitudes, and beliefs of young Americans. Each year’s volume gives results from an annual survey of high school seniors throughout the US. Subjects in the survey include drug use, work, leisure, background, school, interpersonal relationships, military, happiness, religion, and politics. The 2004 copies of the *Overview of Key Findings*, and Volume I and II are now available and can be ordered or checked out through the NPRC. - **NIDA has announced a new campaign**, “Drug Abuse and HIV: Learn the Link.” The campaign targets teens and young adults, as research has shown that many young people are not concerned with becoming infected with HIV. Using televised public service announcements and a new website, www.hiv.drugabuse.gov, NIDA and their partner associations hope to send the message that risky behaviors, such as drug use can lead to HIV infection. The website includes information for teens, parents and educators about the risks of HIV infection from drug use. Links to resources such as webcasts, Research Reports, and the PSA are also available.
- **The Alcohol: Problems and Solutions** website is produced by David J. Hanson, Ph.D., Professor Emeritus of Sociology at the State University of New York at Potsdam. This website has a lot of interesting facts and articles on alcohol that have been well researched. Each month a historical fact or story about alcohol is featured, this one being that the national prohibition began on January 16, 1920.
