### Home Study Courses:

#### Methamphetamine Prevention: An Inquiry

This class requires a thoughtful examination of drug prevention in a quest for information and truth about what will work in methamphetamine prevention. The student undertaking this course is invited to explore existing resources in an effort to understand current thinking and approaches to methamphetamine prevention.

#### Substance Abuse Prevention

This substance abuse prevention course provides comprehensive information about substance abuse prevention, with areas of emphasis in prevention research, prevention program planning, facts about drugs, the cultural context and ethics of prevention, incorporating human development theory into prevention, media and prevention, logic model and evaluation, communication strategies and grant writing.

#### Socioeconomics and Prevention

This course is designed for participants who are motivated to gain knowledge about approaching, understanding, and working with students, adults, and organizations representing the socioeconomic spectrum of poverty, middle class, and wealth.

#### Ethical Decision Making in Substance Abuse Prevention

This is an introductory course to the Ethical Decision making Model and the Code of Ethical Conduct for Prevention Professionals designed for participants who are motivated to apply a code of ethical conduct to their work in the substance abuse prevention and/or related fields.

#### Environmental Prevention Strategies

This substance abuse prevention course provides basic information about substance abuse prevention, with areas of emphasis in evidence-based environmental strategies and overcoming barriers to implementing environmental strategies.

#### Cultural Communities

This course is designed for professionals who are highly motivated to gain in-depth knowledge about approaching and
