This month we would like to focus on two resources featured in this edition of the *NPRC Update*:

First:

One of the items we forward regularly is the “CESAR FAX.” The Center for Substance Abuse Research (CESAR), located in Maryland, has a mission “to inform policymakers, practitioners, and the general public about substance abuse—its nature and extent, its prevention and treatment, and its relation to other problems.” CESAR provides a valuable weekly one-page document (CESAR FAX) about a selected substance abuse topic, maintains a website with substance abuse-related information (www.cesar.umd.edu), and houses a library that is a clearinghouse of information on substance abuse and related topics. We highly recommend that you visit their website and take advantage of the wealth of information you will find.

Second:

Frequently throughout the year we have occasion to forward announcements and links to newly completed studies in substance abuse and related fields. Often, given the volume of information that comes across our desks and the size of the full reports, we don’t read them before we send out the links. We simply send you the links to the

documents and hope you will find them useful. One such item that is located in this issue is the October 1, 2007, Vol. 16, Issue 39 CESAR FAX, which features an announcement about a report entitled: “Prevention Education in America’s Schools: Findings and Recommendations from a Survey of Educators.” This report is based on an online survey administered in April 2006 to a convenience sample of more than 3,500 teachers, administrators and other educators. Based upon the results of the survey, the report makes five recommendations. The authors of the report are from Join Together Online, an organization that provides resources to help community leaders understand and use the most current scientifically valid prevention and treatment approaches.
