Drug Czar in Reno

John Walters, Director of National Drug Control Policy and President Bush's Drug Czar, recently visited Reno and spoke at a Join Together Northern Nevada-sponsored event for local business leaders about the threat posed by a Nevada initiative to legalize marijuana. More than 50 local community leaders attended the private event at the Airport Plaza Hotel. The following day Walters presented a \$500,000 check to local law enforcement to be used for drug trafficking efforts in Northern Nevada.
